## **Conditions of Entry**

#### 2nd December 2018/3rd March 2019

Leaderboard Rules – A high point Leaderboard will run across the 2 events.

Series prizes will be awarded to the winners of each category on the 3rd of March
2019.

- 1. The same combination of horse and rider must compete at both events to be eligible for the Leaderboard winner.
- 2. Winners at each level will be awarded to open rider and young rider.
- 3. Riders must compete at the same level for both competitions to be eligible. (ie. cannot combine points from prelim and novice tests, must be novice tests at both events).
- 4. Open riders must be 17 years and over at the date of the Dec competition.
- 5. Young riders must be under 17 years at the date of the Dec competition.
- 6. Points awarded

6 points for 1<sup>st</sup> place 5 points for 2<sup>nd</sup> place 4 points for 3<sup>rd</sup> place 3 points for 4<sup>th</sup> place 2 points for 5<sup>th</sup> place 1 points for 6<sup>th</sup> place

These points will be awarded over the 2 series.

- 7. In the event of an equal placing both riders will receive the maximum points ie equal  $2^{nd}$  place both 5 points. Then there is no  $3^{rd}$  placing.
- 8. In the event of an equal placing on the Leaderboard the winner shall be determined using the highest combined percentage of tests at the March Competition.

#### **Categories**

Prizes will be awarded in each of the categories below for both Open & YR Riders must have competed at both Series to be eligible for Leaderboard.
