Conditions of Entry - MARCH 5th 2023

1. Entries will close **when classes are full.**
2. Conditions of Entry – by forwarding an entry to Transitions Inc, the rider acknowledges acceptance & understanding of the Conditions of Entry to this event.
3. Disclaimer of Liability – by attending, riders and other attendees acknowledge acceptance & understanding that they participate in this event at their own risk.
4. Rules – this event will be conducted in accordance with the current 2023 EA National dressage Rules and EA General Regulations.
5. Levels – a horse or pony can enter no more than 2 consecutive levels & compete in a maximum of 2 tests per day. Horses must be 4 yrs of age.
6. One horse, one rider – no horse may compete with 2 riders.
7. Final Draw will be posted on or before Thursday 2nd March 2023 on the Transitions website www.transitionsinc.org.au
8. Time of classes may change from published programme . It is the competitor's responsibility to check the draw. Please check for draw updates when you arrive at the event.
9. 'First come first served' – Due to the recent popularity of Transitions Dressage Days entries will be on 'first come first served' basis. If classes fill, horses may be placed on reserve lists, or the organising committee may ballot classes.
10. Eligibility – All horses/ponies are eligible to enter our unofficial competition, the rider **MUST BE A FINANCIAL MEMBER OF EWA** including Adult Riders. There is no maximum age for the rider, **NO DAY INSURANCE IS AVAILABLE.**
11. A rider may ride a pony in unofficial competition from the start of the year they turn 8 years of age, and on horses from the year in which they turn 10 years of age. There is no maximum age for riding horses or ponies in our competition.
12. Entry Classification – Open - 17 yrs & over. Young Riders - under 17 yrs. Adult Riders – must belong to an Adult Rider Club (ARC) and be a financial member of EWA.
13. Stallion disc for stallions must be worn on both sides of either the bridle or saddlecloths of a horse/pony at all times except when in a yard, at our event, including when being handled in a head collar or lunged.
14. Alterations – the program may be altered subject to the organiser's discretion.
15. Entry fee for tests - \$35 per test. Transitions members \$30
16. Ground Fee – a ground fee of \$10 will be charged per horse.
17. Insurance – **NO DAY INSURANCE – Must be EWA or Transitions member.**
18. Saddlery, clothing and equipment – it is the competitors responsibility to comply with the current official EA rules. Wearing jackets and plaiting is optional, horses must be presented neat and tidy.
19. Swabbing – may take place.

20. Refunds – entry fees will be refunded in full for withdrawals before the closing date of entries. Entry fees will not be refunded after the closing date of entries. Medical/Vet Certificates must be submitted within 24 hours of the event for a refund.

22. Arena familiarisation – competitors may bring a horse into the competition space (not arena) in walk only, 1 hour prior to commencement of the competition. All horses must vacate the competition space 20 minutes prior to commencement of the competition.
23. CANTEEN – food and drinks will be available for purchase from the commencement of competition.
24. Dogs – **Strictly NO dogs allowed.**
25. Caution Cards – Transitions events are ‘Goodwill’ events. Transitions appreciate the valuable contribution volunteers & officials make to our sport. It supports the mantra: ‘Respect volunteers & officials’. Where a participant or supporter breaches the EA Code of Conduct, Caution Cards will be issued & details noted.
26. Yards - Please note there are no yards available.
27. Warm up etiquette – As documented on the DWA website and posted at our event. Correct protocol in the warm up arena is expected. There is no lunging allowed in the warm up areas on the oval. If needing to lunge there is an enclosed paddock to the left of the entrance. Please be considerate and do not allow your horse to rip it up. Helmets must be worn when lunging.
28. It is recommended that competitors report to the Marshall/Gear Checker for inspection 20 minutes prior to competing. Gear Checkers will be in orange/yellow vests near the tent.

Gear check

- a) A gear check is required prior to each test.
 - b) All competitors must present to the Gear Steward.
 - c) Once gear checked you must not dismount or leave the warm up area.
 - d) Failure to have a gear check will incur elimination.
29. **Please note: All hay and manure is to be removed and taken home from around your float/Truck. Please keep your vehicles locked when not in attendance.**
